The purpose of this event is to establish a high profile Canadian recruiting event that will help showcase the top lacrosse players in Canada. We have over 75 NCAA schools and coaches confirmed to attend the All Canada Lacrosse Games to watch and connect with the top players in Canada over the course of 3 days. Participating players can expect plenty of exposure and recruitment opportunities while participating in a competitive tournament experience.

The All Canada Lacrosse Games will be played on 5 fields at the Oshawa Civic Recreation Complex. There is a total of 3 turf (Field 6, 5 and 1) and 3 grass fields (Field 2, 3 and 4) all within walking distance of each other. The Fields are clearly marked, below is a site map.



- **Player Check-in** - Will take place inside BUILDING 6 in MEETING ROOM 4 and 5. Signage will be set up on site directing you to the rooms.
- **Washrooms** - Located inside BUILDING 6, and STADIUM 1
- **Trainers Tent** – Trainers tent will be set up on site for medical assistance, tapings and therapies

Upon arrival on June 27th, please enter into the main building to sign in. Sign in will be located in **MEETING ROOM 4 and 5 on the Upper Level.**

We understand that some participants may be finishing exams on Monday. If you cannot arrive at your scheduled sign-in time, do not worry, feel free to sign in with us whenever you arrive.

SIGNIN SCHEDULE

Player Sign In will take place between 9am – 11am, a SPECIFIC sign in time will be confirmed tomorrow once the EVENT schedule is released.

You will receive your event uniform at sign in. If you have yet to pay for the event, you will need to do so at sign-in. NO PAY = NO PLAY.

Each player is already assigned a number as per the recruiting booklet. DO NOT change your number. If you have an issue, please report it to us in MEETING ROOM 4.

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

Each participant will have a team practice with their team and guest coach. The practice schedule will be released on FRIDAY June 24th

OPENING WELCOME

Prior to the start of the event, camp directors and guest NCAA coaches would like to meet briefly with each class. Meeting will take place in the **BOBBY ORR Room** on the main floor of building 6.

RECRUITING SEMINAR

We will be hosting 3 recruiting seminars on **Tuesday June 28th inside the Bobby Orr Meeting Room**. The recruiting seminar will feature an open discussion on the recruiting process, Q and A period, and feature guest coaches. Parents and players are encouraged to attend.

GAME RULES AND FORMAT

- Games will be played as 2 – 25 minute halves of running time
- Teams will switch ends each half
- No timeouts during round robin games (1 timeout per team during elimination games)
- Games will be officiated using NCAA rules -

- Teams are awarded 2 points for a win
- Teams are awarded 1 point for a tie (no tiebreak during round robin, sudden death during Elimination games)
- In the event of a tie in the standings, tie breakers will be determined by:
 - 1- Head to Head Result
 - 2- Goal For/Against Differential
 - 3- Lowest Goals Against

ACADEMICS/SAT/GPA

An integral part of the recruiting process relates to athlete's academics. We are requesting that athletes bring a copy of their most recent academic transcript to the camp. Your transcripts will only be seen by recruiters. We will collect transcripts at sign-in

If you are a **2017 or 2018 YOU ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to bring a copy of your transcript from the Fall or Summer. 2019 players are encouraged to bring a transcript as well.

ALL STAR GAMES

We will be hosting all-star games on Tuesday June 28th. **Nominations will be made based on team coaches selections and NCAA coaches input.**

TEAM ROSTERS

A first draft of rosters will be released FRIDAY JUNE 24th. We are working to create balanced rosters that ensure all participants will receive quality field time and exposure. **YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO SWITCH NUMBERS. Recruiters have received player packages with your assigned numbers.**
